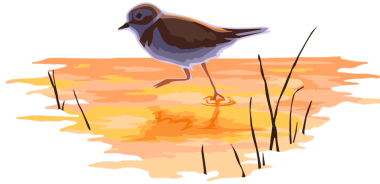

<b>Tasks</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Inspire people to love and protect birds, wildlife, and the natural environment</li> <li>● Attend Hilton Head Audubon Society conservation committee meetings</li> <li>● Stay informed with conservation issues on the island</li> <li>● Engage with members of the community and local leaders through conversation and/or letters concerning issues to help protect birds and preserve their habitat</li> <li>● Assist with local conservation issues such as shorebird protection signage, climate change advocacy, responsible management of feral cats, and monitoring local land use</li> </ul>	
<b>Skills</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● A desire to give back to your community in support of local conservation efforts</li> <li>● Willingness to engage with people and be an ambassador for HHA</li> <li>● A passion for birds and creating awareness of the plight of birds by educating and influencing people through conversation efforts and letters</li> </ul>	
<b>Setting</b>	
Varies – could be visiting a park, land development, writing or researching in support of selected advocacy topics on a computer, or participating in a community meeting	
<b>Time Commitment</b>
